

Adelaide University Sport Scholarship Terms and Conditions

1. Details of Participation

Information on how to enter forms part of these Details of Participation and entry is deemed as acceptance of them.

Applications open at 9am, Wednesday February 5, 2020 and close at 5pm Friday, 21 March 2019 for all scholarships excluding the Adelaide University Sport President Scholarships.

Applications not received by that date or not completed in accordance with the Details of Participation will not be eligible to receive a scholarship.

2. Who can apply

The applicant must:

- a) be a University of Adelaide student proceeding towards a degree or diploma
- b) be an active financial member of an Adelaide University Sport Club
- c) make a considerable contribution to their chosen Adelaide University Sport Club

3. How to apply

Scholarships can be applied for by completing an application form in full at [Adelaide University Sport 2020 Scholarship Application Form](#)

Applications will not be considered unless an application is completed in full and the required all supporting documentation are received by Adelaide University Sport before the closing date, 5pm Friday, 21 March 2019. This is the sole responsibility of the applicant.

4. Selection Process

The Blues Committee of Adelaide University Sport meets every year to rank the applicants.

Scholarships will be determined in accordance with the following categories:

- a) Competition at a High Level of Sport
- b) Competition in which the candidate provides enthusiasm and encouragement to other club members
- c) Coaching
- d) Service to the Club Administration

5. Notification

Applicants will be informed of the outcome by email.

6. Requirements for scholarship recipients

The Award of the scholarship will depend upon the recipient agreeing to the following:

- a) Abide by usual University of Adelaide regulations
- b) Comply with Adelaide University Sport policies and those of Adelaide University Sport Club the recipient is a member of.
- c) Maintain a high standard of conduct and bearing at all times when representing Adelaide University Sport.
- d) Provide updates in writing midyear/end of year or after a major competition indicating details of sporting activity to Adelaide University Sport.
- e) Remain a student at the University during the scholarship period
- f) Attend the Adelaide University Sport Blues Function

- g) Complete 2 hours of voluntary work with Adelaide University Sport as required by Adelaide University Sport

In addition, the following scholarship specific requirements apply for scholarship recipients:

The AU Sport President's Scholarship

In addition to the requirements outlined in the General Terms and Conditions, applicants for the Sport President's Scholarship must be a first-year University of Adelaide student proceeding towards a degree or diploma and become a member of the selected AU Sport Club upon receiving the Scholarship and make a considerable contribution to their chosen AU Sport Club upon receiving the Scholarship.

The Bill Scammell Sport Scholarship

In addition to the requirements outlined in the General Terms and Conditions, if awarded to a club coach, the coach must have been a coach for at least three years.

The Don Stranks Scholarship

In addition to the requirements outlined in the General Terms and Conditions, applicants for the Don Strank's Scholarship must be an athlete with the AU Cricket Club or AU Football club.

The Charlie Jessop Sport Scholarship Terms and Conditions

In addition to the requirements outlined in the General Terms and Conditions, applicants for the Charlie Jessop Sport Scholarship must be a University of Adelaide Law student

The People's Choice Credit Union Scholarship Terms and Conditions

In addition to the requirements outlined in the General Terms and Conditions, applicants for the People's Choice Credit Union (PPCU) Scholarship must comply with the following requirements:

- The scholarship recipient cannot be linked to any other financial institution
- Scholarship funds of \$1,000 will be deposited into a People's Choice Credit Union account to be accessed by the recipient along with a PPCU shirt to be worn for images to be used for PPCU promotional purposes
- The scholarship recipient will be asked to participate in a branch activity e.g. scholarship winners meet and greet, update People's Choice Credit Union on how they are going, quarterly update with PPCU.
- A student profile including images will be request for social media and newsletter purposes which the recipient will also post to their on social channels with relevant hashtags.
- Scholarship recipient will be asked to complete and end of year review on how they have used the funds, results etc

Applications for these scholarships will be reviewed by the People's Choice Credit Union Scholarship judging committee.
